This is what led us to take the biggest leap we have taken since the foundation of the company. After three years of relentless R&D, we are proud to introduce the debut of Jones Outerwear.

Our goal with Jones Outerwear is to do things differently, and develop new winter apparel concepts that blend comfort, performance and sustainability in a fresh look and functional fit. With a laser focus on essentials and a clear intention for each piece, we designed three unique, movement focused kits that will keep you cool, dry and comfortable through a wide variety of conditions and objectives.

The Jones Outerwear development process mirrored how we make our boards - work with the best people, years of test/tweak/repeat, countless prototypes, and learn from the leaders of the industry while keeping an open mind that there is always a better way to do things.

Design innovative mountain gear that sets new performance standards and be a leader in manufacturing sustainability, environmental outreach, and backcountry education.

If only snowboard gear grew on trees, born from simply seed, soil, water, and sunshine, with a rogue root pushing up the sidewalk as their only impact. Manufacturing snowboards, outerwear, or any of the gear we make, demands resources with a more complex footprint than a fruit tree, but that doesn't stop us from holistically tending to our production like an orchard.

We start with unique ECO-performance designs, the seeds of our products, that utilize innovative sustainable materials whenever possible. Our partner factories are our rich soil, cutting edge facilities where our designs come to life while providing steady employment and social stability to the workforce. The water and energy we use is never taken for granted and we strive to minimize our carbon footprint by analyzing the environmental impact at every stage of our products' life cycle and investing in renewable energy.

We are very proud of the fruits of our labor. We make performance standard setting products that unlock limitless potential for human creativity and well being. We also give back to the global community through jobs and donations to environmental non-profits. No doubt there will be challenges as we work to make our garden ever greener, but we're excited to share our successes and failures publicly. We've got nothing to hide in our orchard. Every business decision we make is firmly rooted in our desire to grow the sweetest, most sustainably produced snowboards, outerwear and backcountry gear we can.

Environment non-profit partners

Our quest to improve the sustainability of our products is only one facet of our environmental efforts. We strive to take real action against climate change through our partnerships with the non-profit organizations 1% For The Planet, Protect Our Winters (POW), and Community Carbon Trees (CCT), plus public fundraising campaigns that help support them.



1% For The Planet

1% For The Planet is a growing association of businesses that have pledged to give 1% of their sales directly to sustainability-oriented non-profits. The mission of 1% For The Planet is to leverage this alliance of financially committed businesses to support a healthy planet.

"We understand that supporting environmental efforts is important to our customers," said Jeremy Jones. "As a member of 1% For The Planet our customers are assured that their support goes beyond just our profits. We are proudly accountable for giving back to the earth."

1% For The Planet member companies support thousands of non-profit organizations helping to save land, protect forests, rivers and oceans, make agricultural and energy production more sustainable, get toxins out of the environment, plastics out of the oceans and more. 1% for the Planet carefully vets each nonprofit for track record, credibility and impact and annually verifies that members are making their contributions. More than \$100 million dollars has been invested by 1% for the Planet members in the last ten years.



Protect Our Winters

Protect Our Winters is a climate change organization founded by Jeremy Jones in 2007. The mission of POW is to engage and mobilize the winter sports community to lead the fight against climate change. POW is the environmental center point of this global community and unites brands, athletes and communities towards a common goal of reducing climate change's effects on our sports and local economies. The collective power of the winter sports community is massive and POW helps organize the effort to step up and take responsibility to save a season that fuels our passions and provides jobs and economic vitality to mountain regions.

Jones' 1% For The Planet donation to POW is used to support their efforts to push climate change legislation in Washington D.C., fight coal exports in the Pacific Northwest, and promote climate change awareness campaigns such as the *Outdoor State*, a new campaign that connects like-minded outdoor enthusiasts and gives them the tools to let their voices be heard as climate change activists.



Community Carbon Trees (CCT)

Community Carbon Trees (CCT) fights against climate change by reforesting clear cut swaths of Costa Rican rainforest with a wide diversity of native tropical trees. The reforestation and protection of trees is truly an important step toward the mitigation of climate change as forests pull carbon dioxide from the atmosphere and recycle it into oxygen. The benefits of reforestation in Costa Rica are greater than most other places on Earth because tropical trees are able to grow 365 days-a-year thanks to Costa Rica's unique location within 10 degrees of the Equator.

With our total donations to CCT, Jones Snowboards has supported the planting of 9000 trees on a previously deforested cattle ranch surrounding a stunning waterfall. The trees are now 3-5 years old and the forest is already flourishing with secondary growth and wildlife.

OUTERWEAR ETHOS

We believe there is a better way.

A better way to manufacture apparel so it does less harm, and lasts longer. A better way to protect yourself from nature's wrath without sacrificing comfort, mobility and breathability. And a better way to get more versatility out of fewer pieces, to design clothing that adapts to nature's moods.

When we set out to start making apparel this is what drove us. To do things differently, and bring new winter apparel concepts to the world that blend comfort, performance and sustainability in a fresh look and fit. Every piece in the collection is purposefully designed to be extremely functional to help you unlock your wildest dreams in the mountains.

Every piece in the collection is also built with the most sustainable materials possible. All of our materials are Oekotex and/or Bluesign certified, and a vast majority are recycled. We use only 100% organic cotton, 100% recycled down and 100% non-mulesed merino wool. We also use PFC-Free DWR treatments on all our fabrics, except for GORE-TEX PRO. DWR is a necessary evil of waterproofing and GORE-TEX PRO does not yet offer a PFC-Free DWR option. When they do, we will use it.

The social impact of our products is equally important to us as the environmental impact. Our production facilities are all BSCI or WRAP certified, which guarantees that the people who make our apparel receive fair salaries and that they can work in a safe and clean working environment. As a member of 1% For The Planet, every tee, jacket or pant we sell also gives back and helps protect clean air, clean water and a healthy planet.

This is not about putting our logo on more products. From upcycled down to body mapped GORE-TEX PRO, this is about making cutting edge apparel that performs just like we move through the mountains - with complex simplicity. One foot in front of the other, but no wasted steps, and no wasted energy. This is apparel we believe in every step of the way.




















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
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






















Organic apparel
