INTRODUCTION

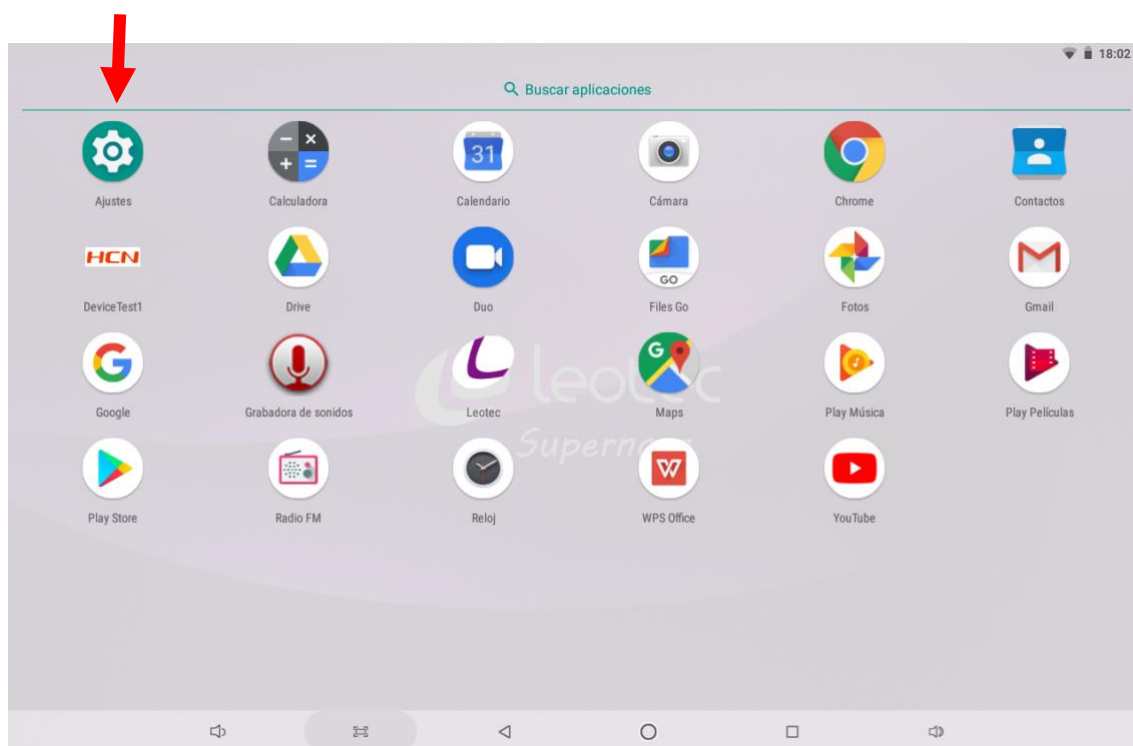
First use

Battery charge

Before using your LEOTEC Tablet for the first time, fully charge the battery. Connect the supplied adapter / charger. Attention: Use ONLY the LEOTEC charger / adapter supplied with your device or a compatible model with exactly the same specifications. The LEOTEC Tablet will turn on and start charging. The battery icon of the main interface will indicate when the device is fully charged.

Setting

We recommend that the first time you use the Tablet LEOTEC follow the assistant configuration of core values such as language, location, date, time, security options and backup. You can re-edit them in the Settings section.



Appearance and buttons:

1.1 Touch Panel

10.1" multipoint capacitive touch panel: to operate, click or drag on the touch panel.

1.2 On / Off

On:

Hold down the power button until the display prime r a screen,

Then the operating system will begin to load, and the main interface will appear.

Power off: On the main interface, press the power button for 2 seconds to turn off the device. The system will offer the option to turn off r or Restart. Choose the desired option.

Lock screen: Press the power button once to lock or unlock the screen.

On the lock screen, slide your finger from bottom to top to unlock the Tablet.

You can also launch the camera app by sliding from the lower right vertex to the center of the screen or even launch the voice recognition app by sliding from the lower left vertex to the center of the screen.

Note:

1. When the battery is discharged the system will turn off automatically.
2. A sudden system shutdown, reset, etc., may cause the system to take a long time to reboot with the consequent loss of information.

1. 3 Key V-

Long press low Audio volume

1. 4 V + key:

Long press up Audio volume

1. 5 Headset

Standard 3.5mm headset connection.

1. 6 MicroSD / TF card reader

Memory expansion through MicroSD / TF card interface.

1. 7 My cro USB and OTG

Micro USB jack: can use this speed Internet access is for broadcasting data to / from a computer, charging the battery í to (use USB A to micro) or to connect a USB flash drive or external peripheral (keyboard, mouse, external hard drive, etc.)

1. 8 Reset: allows to shut down the system in case of blockage.

Observation or n: Do not use the RESET unless you cannot turn off the device by normal means. It may damage the device.

1. 9 Load

Battery charger connection. Attention: ONLY USE THE CHARGER SUPPLIED BY THE MANUFACTURER OR SOME APPROVED BY HIMSELF.

Battery charge:

Before the first use of the device, please charge the battery 100% for at least 6 hours the first 2 times, the following times only 4 hours will suffice.

Note: This device has an internal Lithium battery. Charging must be done with a standard USB adapter approved by the manufacturer.

To prolong the life of the battery we suggest letting the battery discharge by using it regularly.

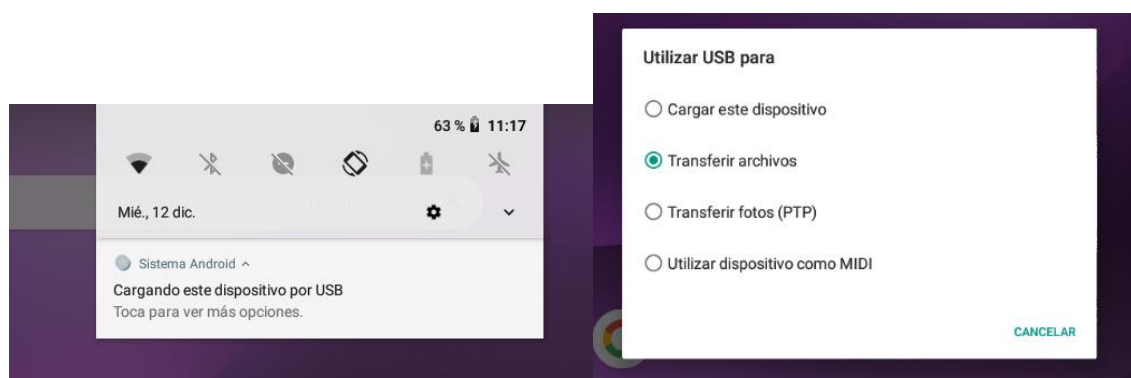
Observations:

1. If you do not use the device for a long period of time, we suggest charging the battery at least once a month.
2. If the device automatically turns off as a result of total battery discharge, we suggest charging the battery for some time before using it again.
3. The battery charge time will be even longer if it is being used while charging.

2. Connection to the computer (PC)

Use the USB cable (micro to USB A) to connect the device to a PC .

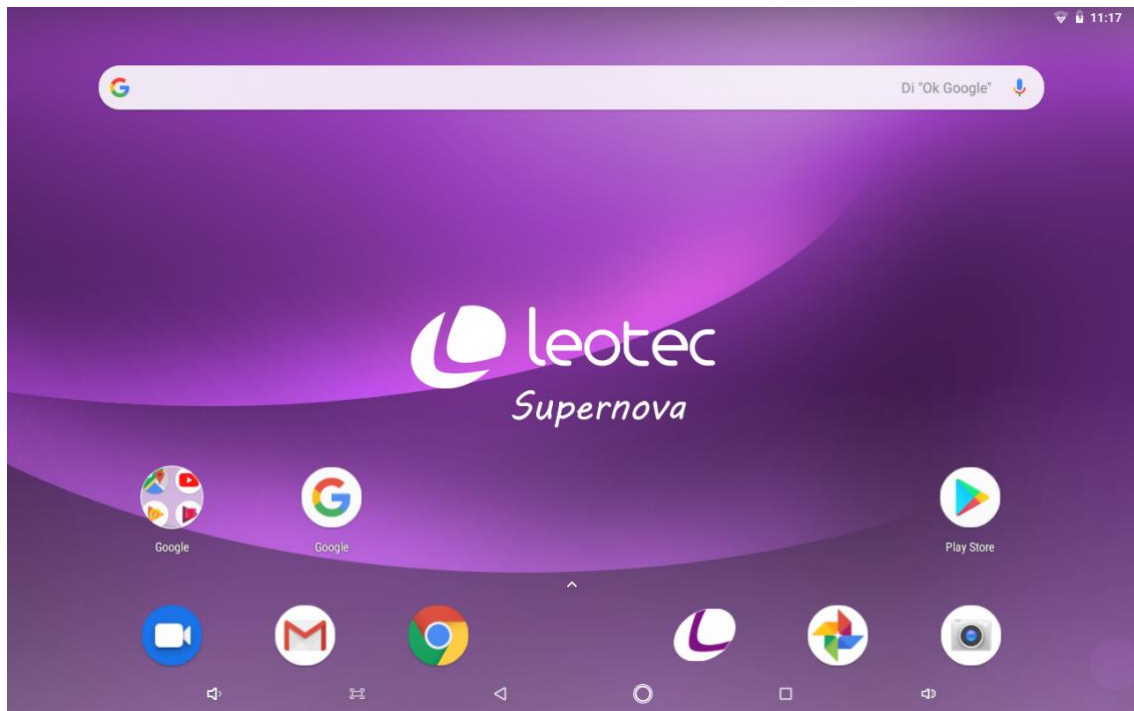
Once the tablet is connected, slide the notification bar and select the USB work mode in the Transfer files option.



With the transfer mode can be selected file copy and delete files on the device and on the memory card from your computer.

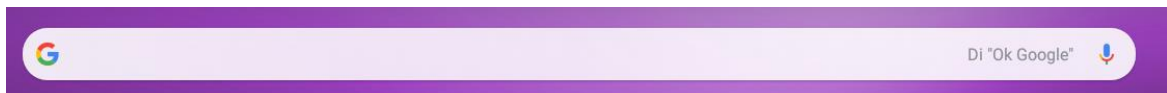
3. Operation interface

After startup it will enter the main interface.



In the main body of the screen the icons and Widgets that the user places are housed, being able to expand to the right side creating additional screens in which new shortcuts, bookmarks and Widgets can be added.

Top search bar:



It allows either to perform a search on Google, writing what you want to search or doing a voice search (in any case you must be connected to the Internet).

Bottom Navigation Bar:



From left to right, reduce the audio volume V , Screen capture, Rewind, Return to the main screen, View recent applications, Increase audio volume.

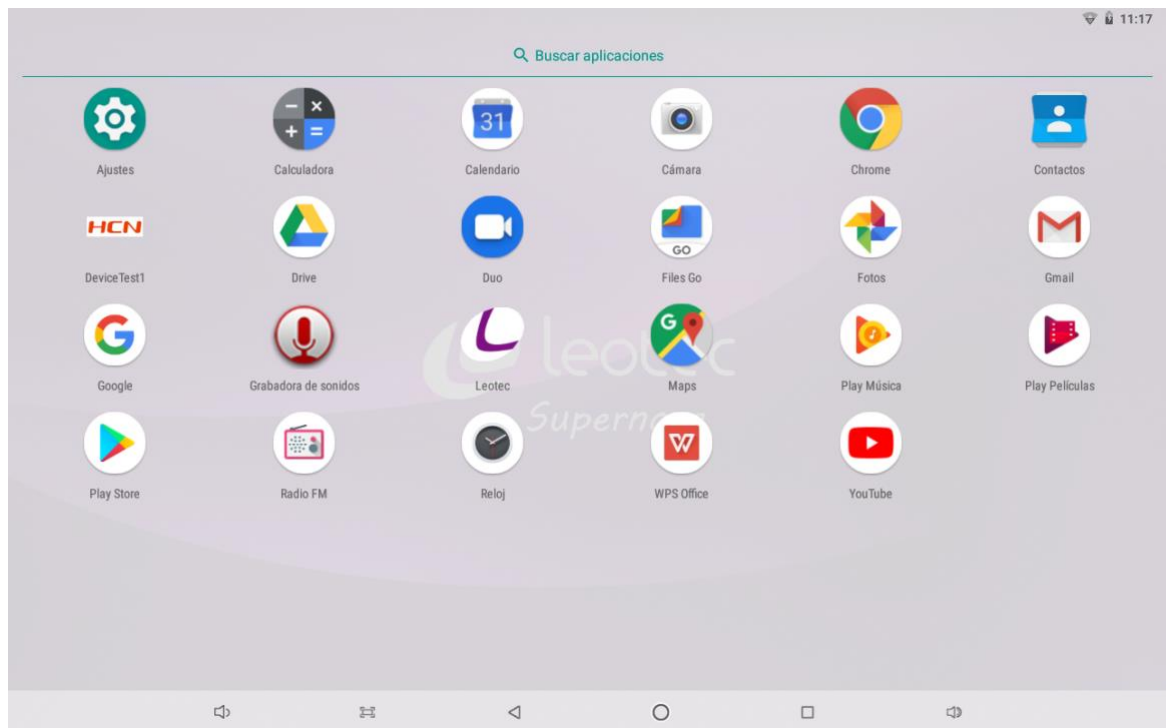
Favorite application bar:



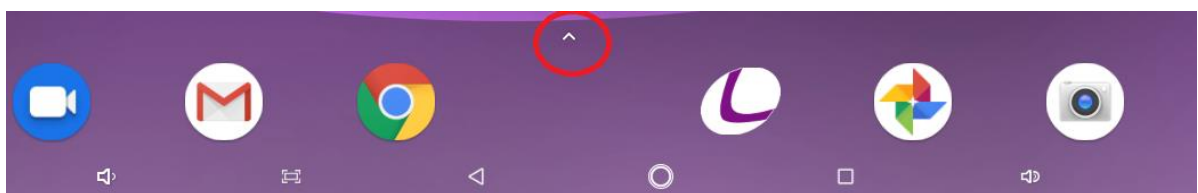
In this space you can drag and drop those applications that are used more frequently and thus have more comfortable access. A maximum of 7 icons or folders fit. To create a container folder, you simply have to drag an icon on top of the other until both are inside the circle. Once the folder is created, the name can be edited by clicking on it.

Installed applications:

To visualize all available applications, simply slide your finger from the bottom of the screen upwards while on the main screen or interface.



You can also click once on the small arrow located on the favorite applications bar.



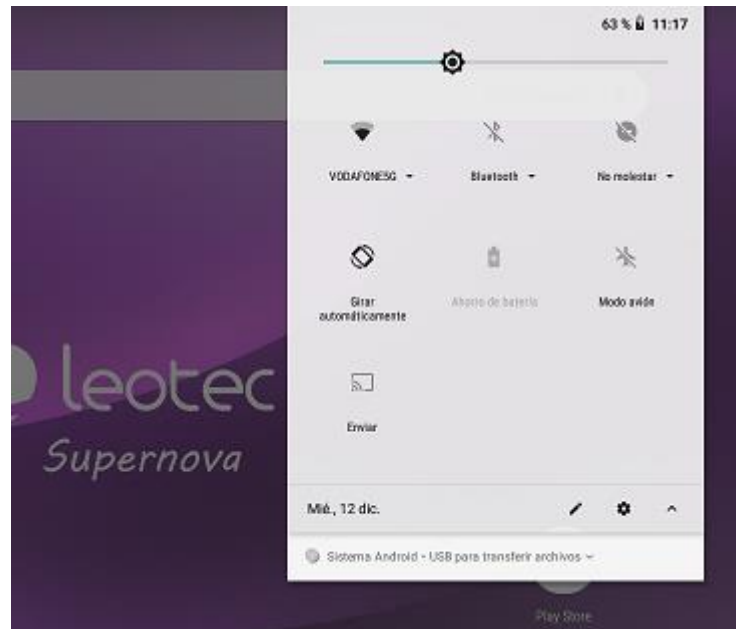
Applications are programs that run when the user wishes and stop working when the user leaves the application. They can be installed by downloading them through the store or through web pages offering Android applications.

Status bar and Notifications:

In the upper right corner is the status zone:



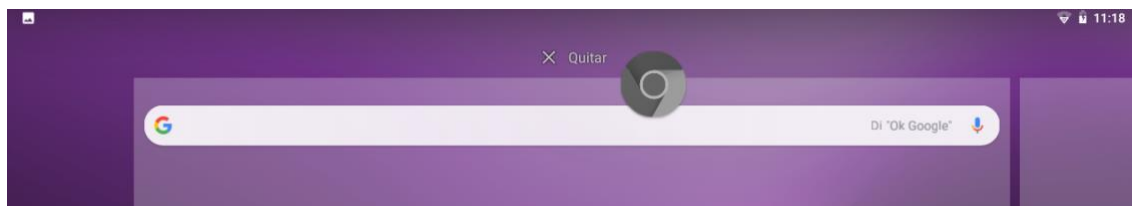
By default, the current time and battery status will always be displayed. If we are connected to a Wi-Fi network or have the Bluetooth connection active, they will also appear here. Sliding once from top to bottom you can access some quick settings. Sliding a second time on this drop-down access other settings.



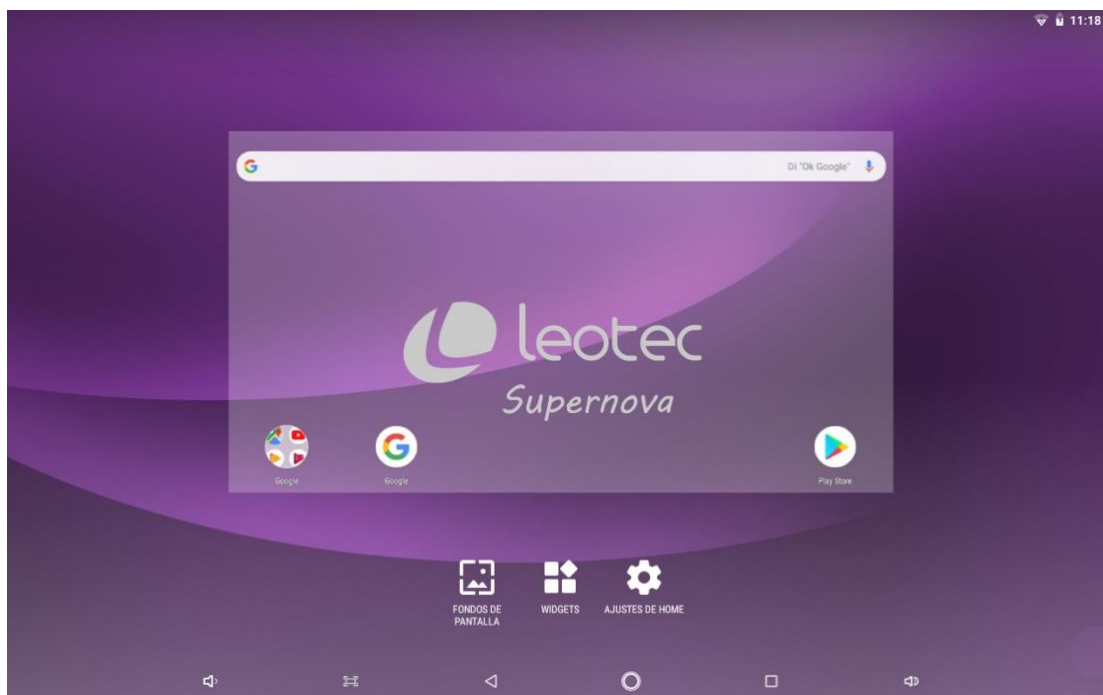
Operational use:

Move Icons: By pressing and holding an icon for 2 seconds, you can drag it anywhere on the interface. You can also bring it closer to the right side of the screen to create a new screen.

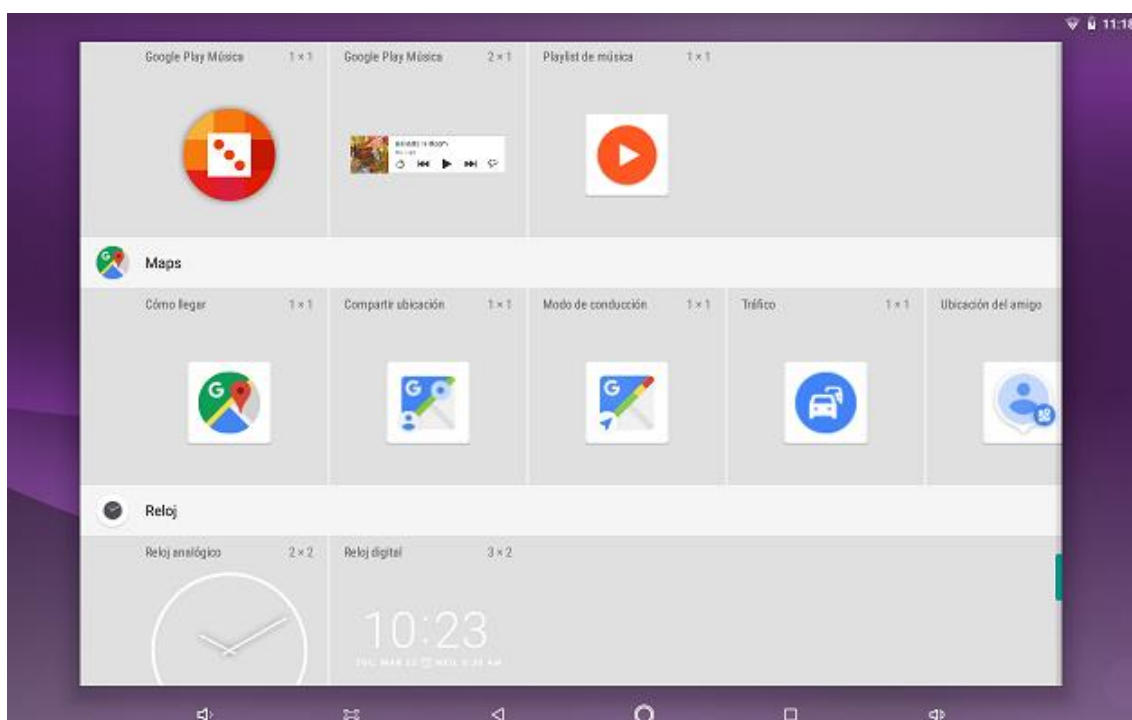
Remove icons: Press and hold an icon for 2 seconds, drag it to the deleted icon represented by an X at the top of the screen, once it turns gray, release it to remove the icon



Change wallpaper: If you press within the main screen for 2 seconds, the menu will appear by which you can either set a wallpaper or add Widgets to the screen.



Place Widgets: Widgets are small programs that run continuously and easily accessible that can be placed and displayed on any of the screens. By default, the Tablet has some basic Widgets, but as new applications are installed, if they have widgets, they will appear here. To place a Widget on the main screen you have to press and hold on one of them, present the location and release to place the widget definitely.

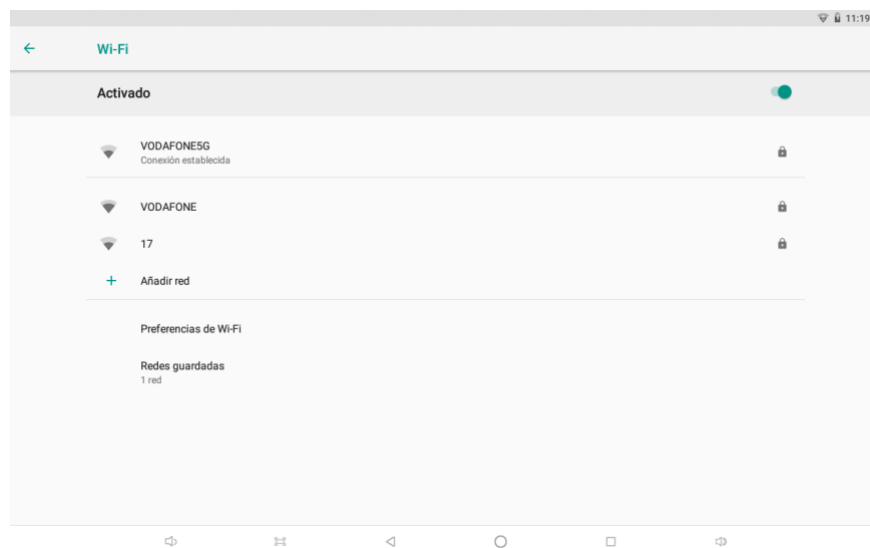


4. Basic settings

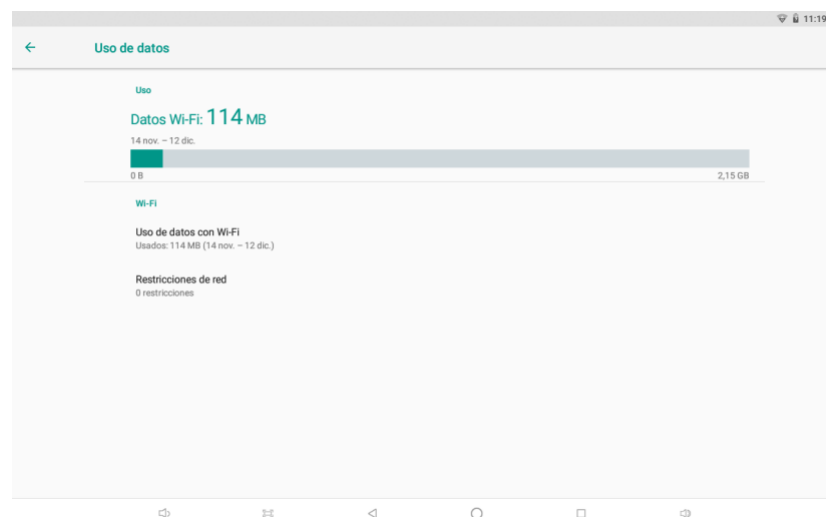
Settings: Click on the **Settings** icon, access the configuration interface .

4.1 Network and Internet:

Wi - Fi: Activate the Wi - Fi network and connect to any Wi - Fi that is within the coverage area.



Data use: It allows to find out the total data consumption as well as to establish configurations that allow saving or restricting.



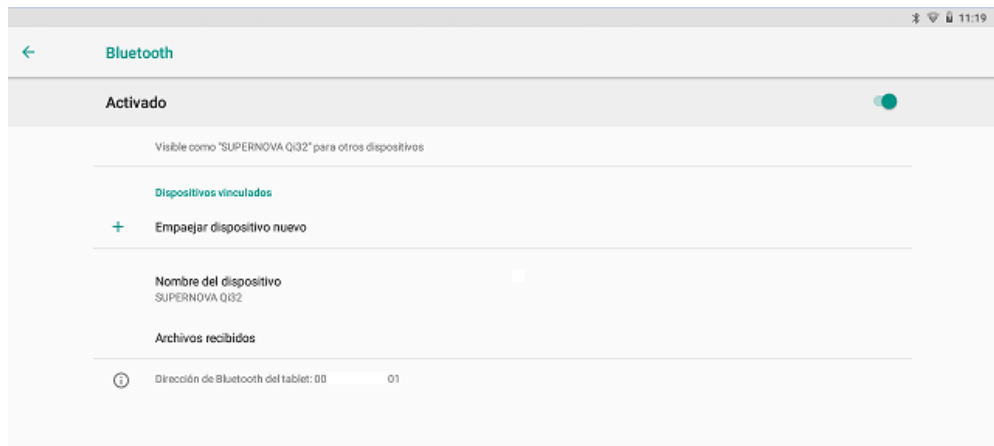
Share connection: Share your internet connection to other devices.

VPN: Add and configure virtual private networks VPN (Virtual Private Network)

Flight mode: Enables flight mode (when used on board of one aircraft)

4.2 Connected devices

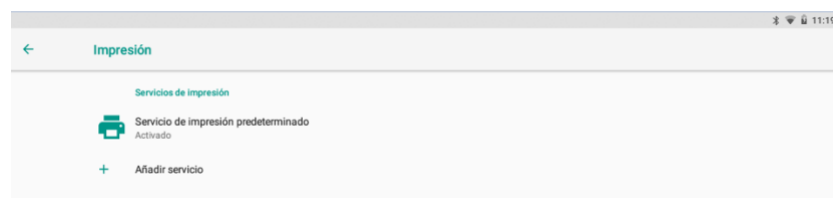
Bluetooth: Enable Bluetooth and pair with available devices that are within the coverage area.



Send screen: Allows you to send multimedia content from the tablet to a screen that is compatible with this technology.

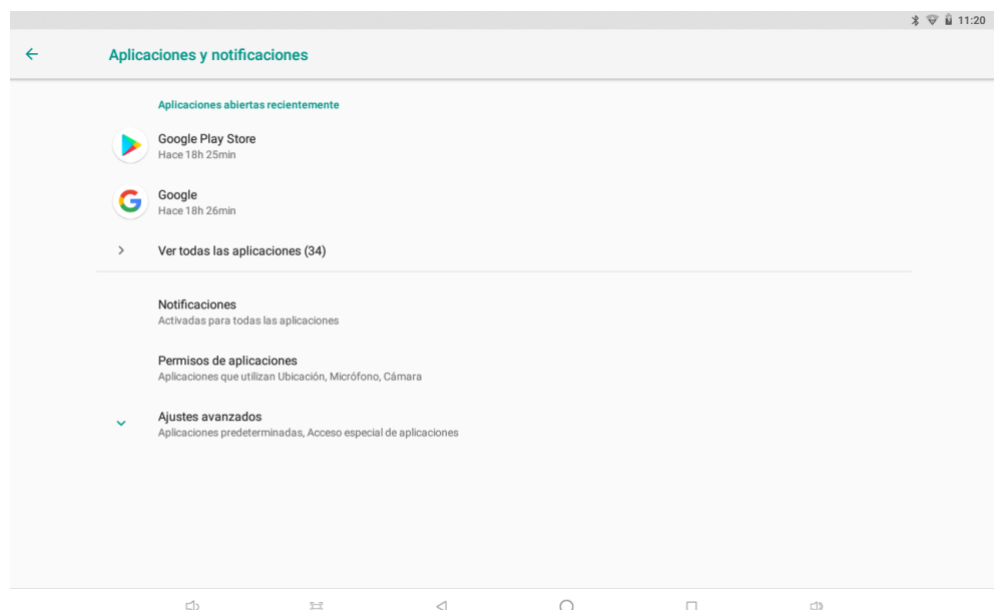

Recently opened applications: All applications that have been recently opened are displayed.

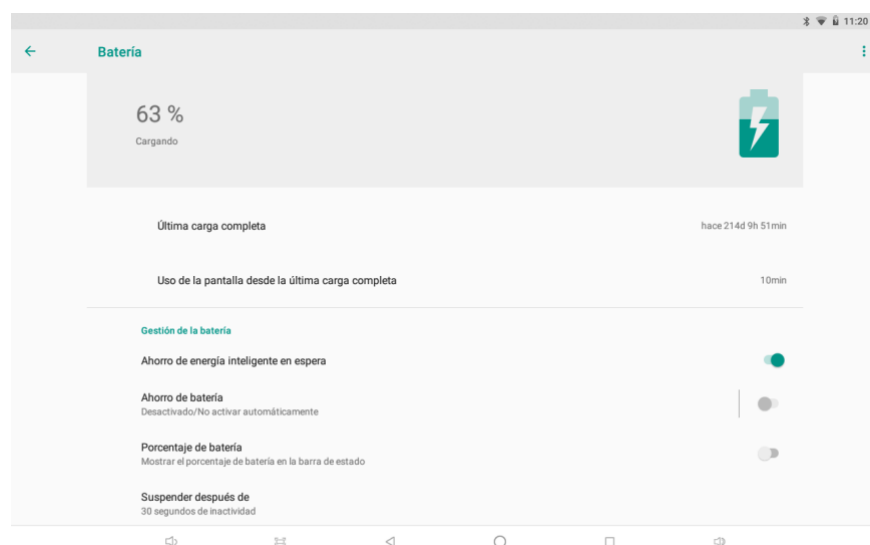
Notifications: Adjust and establish which installed applications can notify us with alerts or messages.

Application permissions: Management of all the permissions that applications have installed on the Tablet.

Advanced Settings: Other settings related to data usage optimization, battery, data restrictions, etc.

4.4 Battery

From here you can visualize the state of charge of the battery and a detailed monitoring of the consumption since the last full charge. T Iso can be managed parameters that directly affect consumption and battery saving.



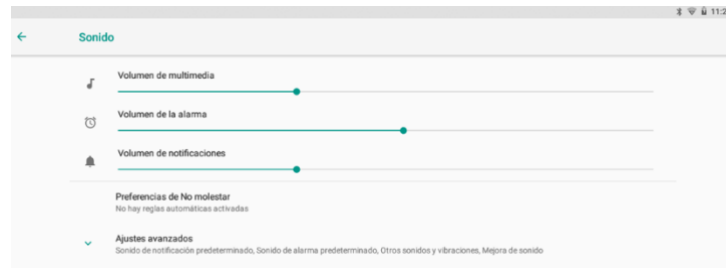
4.5 Screen

Settings related to the screen such as brightness level, wallpaper, sleep time and other advanced settings such as automatic screen rotation or font size.



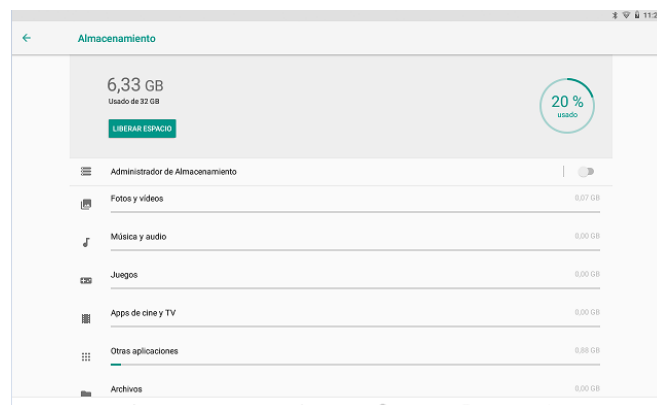
4.6 Sound

Management of all the parameters related to the audio and sound of the Tablet. Multimedia volume, alarm and notifications. From here you configure the type of sound and tone for alarm and notifications as well as you can enable or disable sounds when you touch the screen.



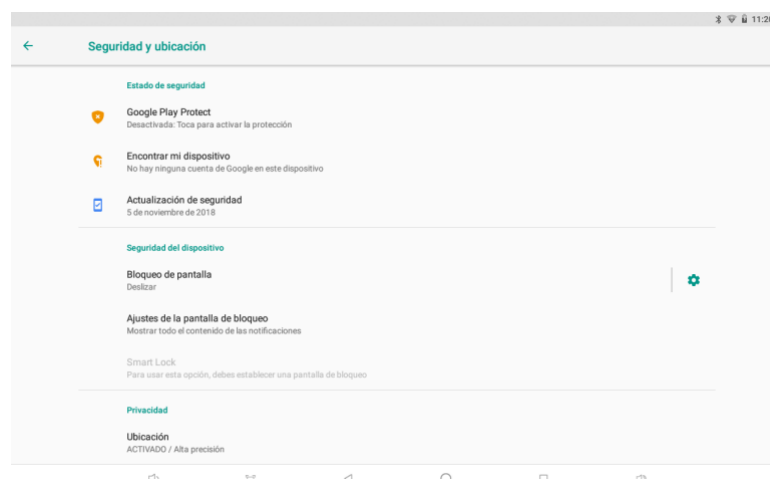
4. 7 Storage

Information regarding the internal storage capacity of the Tablet and the amount of space occupied with respect to the total available. Clicking on the internal storage will show how the occupied space is repaired and you can also proceed to free up space.



4. 8 Security and location

All settings related to the device's security status and privacy are managed from this screen. Aspects such as screen lock type, enable or disable location, encryption etc.

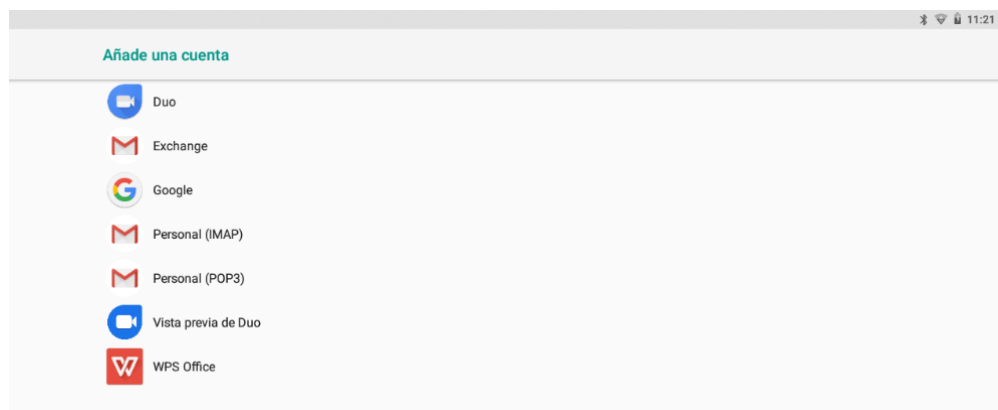
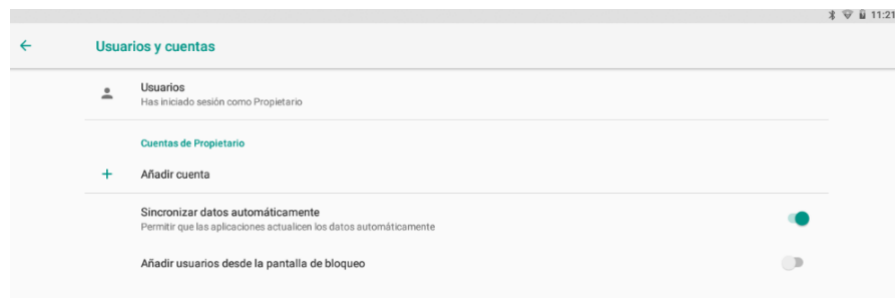


4. 09 User and accounts

Administration of the user accounts of access to the tablet and of the accounts of access to Google and of the other accounts that are used after the installation of applications, for example Mail , Skype, etc ...

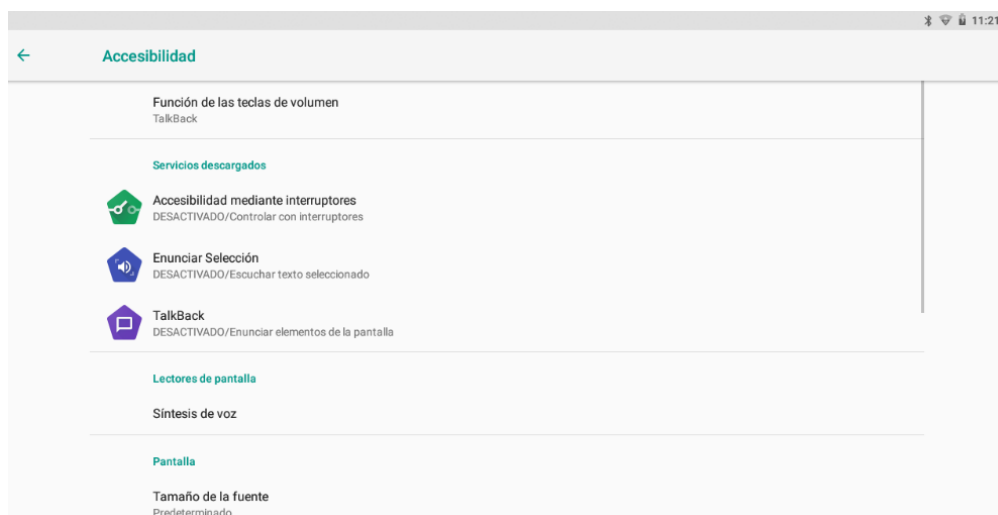
By default, the Tablet has a single user who is the owner, but you can create different accounts and determine the type of access.

4.12 System

Settings related to the Tablet system.

Language and text input: Allow you to change the language of use of the Tablet, set the automatic spelling correction, the type of physical and virtual keyboard, etc.

Adjusting f Check and Time: Set the date and time, select the time zone and select the format of the date

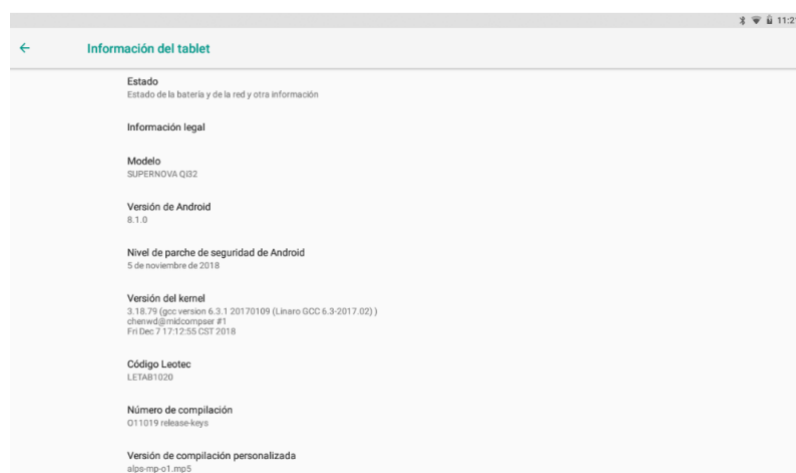
Backup: From here you can manage the backup copies of the Tablet by using the Google account and the Google Drive service.

System update: Android system version information and place from which the existence of new system updates and security patches is verified.

Recovery options: To reset the network parameters, Bluetooth, applications or delete all the data on the Tablet to default values and reset to factory settings.

Tablet information: Information regarding **the tablet** model, system version, security patch, build number.

How to uninstall an application?

- (1) . Enter "Settings" > "Applications and notifications " and the list will show my installed apps.
- (2) . Click on the app you want to uninstall, and you will enter the following interface
- (3) . Click on the DESIN S TALAR button and it will proceed to uninstall

** Note: Please note that the applications that are preinstalled by default cannot be uninstalled since they are part of the system. Forcing their detention or disabling them could have a serious impact on the normal operation of the device.*



5. Troubleshooting

The tablet does not start or does not show image?

Verify battery charge. Connect the power charger to the connector of your device and wait. If the battery is completely depleted, charging 5 -6 hours will be enough to take autonomy.

Can't charge the tablet battery with the charger?

Test by connecting the Tablet to another 5V 2A charger. Most LEOTEC tablets allow battery charging connected to the USB port of a computer using the supplied cable.

Forgot password or unlock pattern?

With the Tablet turned off press the VOL + button and without releasing press the power button for about 5 seconds. Remove pressure only from the power button and wait for the menu. Enter recovery mode by pressing VOL + to select and VOL - to confirm. Now on the "no **commands**" screen you must press the power button and without releasing press only the VOL + button once. With the volume keys you can scroll to "Wipe **data / Factory reset**" and confirm by pressing the power button once. Now you must scroll to the option "Yes - **delete all user data**" and confirm. This will erase all data.

In any case you can always enter the LEOTEC website and in the download area you can locate the original Firmware and the update guide for your tablet model (Ex: LETAB 10 2 0) to restore your Android [™] system from your computer .

Can't you play videos that you can watch on your computer?

In the same way that in a computer we need to install codecs to be able to reproduce according to which extensions and video formats, the same happens in the tablet. Access the Market and locate the application of co decs that interests you.

The tablet starts and stays with the stop animation and fails to reach the unlock menu?

It is possible that some recently installed application may not be set to be used on a tablet or is consuming too much working memory. Enter the LEOTEC website and download area, search for the original Firmware and your tablet model guide to restore your Android [™] system from your computer.
